Mae'r system ar gyfer cefnogi plant a phobl ifanc ag Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig (AAA) ac anabledd yng Nghymru yn newid. Mae Llywodraeth Cymru yn cyflwyno system newydd fwy hyblyg ac ymatebol ar gyfer diwallu anghenion plant ag anghenion addysgol arbennig neu anableddau ac mae'n ymdrechu i gyflwyno system addysg gwbl gynhwysol ar gyfer dysgwyr Cymru.

Bydd y system newydd yn sicrhau:

- bod anghenion yn cael eu nodi'n gynnar, eu diwallu'n gyflym a bod pob dysgwr yn cael ei gefnogi i gyrraedd ei botensial.
- bod ein gweithwyr proffesiynol yn fedrus ac yn hyderus o ran nodi anghenion a datblygu strategaethau i helpu dysgwyr i oresgyn eu rhwystrau i ddysgu.
- bod y dysgwr yn ganolog i bopeth a wnawn a'i fod, ynghyd â'i rieni/gofalwyr, yn bartneriaid cyfartal yn ei ddysgu. (Ymarfer sy'n Canolbwyntio ar yr Unigolyn)

O fis Medi 2021, bydd y system newydd yn cael ei chyflwyno'n raddol dros yr ychydig flynyddoedd nesaf (2021 - 2024). Dyma rai o'r negeseuon allweddol am y newidiadau hyn a'r hyn y gallant ei olygu i chi a'ch plentyn.

## Y Negeseuon Allweddol

- Bydd y term Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol (ADY) yn disodli'r termau Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig (AAA) ac Anawsterau ac Anableddau Dysgu (AAD).
- Bydd Cydlynwyr Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig (Cydlynwyr AAA) mewn ysgolion bellach yn cael eu galw'n Cydlynwyr Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol (Cydlynwyr ADY).
- Bydd y Côt ADY gorfodol ar gyfer y system newydd yn cynnwys plant a phobl ifanc rhwng 0 a 25 oed. Mae hyn yn golygu y bydd gan golegau blynyddoedd cynnar ac addysg bellach ddyletswyddau o dan y Ddeddf, ond nid yw hyn yn cynnwys addysg uwch na phrentisiaethau.
- Mae'r system raddedig bresennol o Weithredu yn y Blynyddoedd Cynnar/Gweithredu gan yr Ysgol, Gweithredu yn y Blynyddoedd Cynnar a

Mwy/Gweithredu gan yr Ysgol a Mwy a Datganiadau yn cael ei disodli yn ystod y 3 blynedd nesaf.

- Bydd pob plentyn a pherson ifanc sydd ag Angen Dysgu Ychwanegol (ADY) a nodwyd sy'n gofyn am Ddarpariaeth Ddysgu Ychwanegol yn cael Cynllun Datblygu Unigol (CDU).
- Bydd y Cynllun Datblygu Unigol yn disodli'r holl gynlluniau unigol eraill. Bydd Cynlluniau Datblygu Unigol, y mae eu hangen ar blant o dan oed ysgol gorfodol h.y. yn y blynyddoedd cynnar, yn cael eu cynnal gan Awdurdodau Lleol.
- Bydd y rhan fwyaf o Gynlluniau Datblygu Unigol yn cael eu cynnal gan yr ysgol ond gallant hefyd gael eu cynnal gan yr Awdurdod Lleol ar gyfer y dysgwyr hynny sydd â'r anghenion mwyaf cymhleth.

## NEW ARRANGEMENTS FOR SUPPORTING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND DISABILITIES

Date: June 2022

Dear Parent/Guardian/Carer

Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal Act (ALNET 2018)

The system for supporting children and young people with Special Educational Needs (SEN) and disability in Wales is changing. The Welsh Government is bringing in a new more flexible and responsive system of meeting the needs of children with SEN or disabilities and is striving to deliver a fully inclusive education system for the learners of Wales.

The new system will ensure:

- needs are identified early, addressed quickly and all learners are supported to reach their potential.
- our professionals are skilled and confident in identifying needs and deploying strategies to help learners overcome their barriers to learning.
- that the learner is at the centre of everything we do and that they and their parents/ carers are equal partners in their learning. (Person Centred Practice)

From September 2021 the new system will be brought in gradually over the next few years (2021 -2024). Here are some of the key messages about these changes and what they may mean for you and your child.

### **Key Messages**

- The term Additional Learning Needs (ALN) will replace the terms Special Educational Needs (SEN) and Learning Difficulties and Disabilities (LDD).
- Special Educational Needs Coordinators (SENCOs) in schools will now be called Additional Learning Needs Coordinators (ALNCOs).
- The mandatory ALN Code for the new system will cover children and young people aged 0-25 years. This means that early years and further education colleges will have duties under the Act, but this does not include higher education or apprenticeships.
- The current graduated system of Early Years/School Action, Early Years/School Action Plus and Statements is being replaced over the course of the next 3 years.

- All children and young people with an identified Additional Learning Need (ALN) that requires Additional Learning Provision (ALP) will have an Individual Development Plan (IDP).
- The IDP will replace all other individual plans. IDPs for children under compulsory school age, who require them, i.e. in the early years, will be maintained by Local Authorities.
- Most Individual Development Plans will be maintained by the school but may also be maintained by the Local Authority for those learners with the most complex needs.
- The Act expects that all partners such as Education, Health and Social Care will work in collaboration to support children and young people with ALN.
- There will be increased opportunities for children, young people, parents/carers to contribute to the creation and maintenance of Individual Development Plans through Person Centred Practice (PCP).
- It is expected that working together more closely should help to avoid disagreements.
- All reasonable steps will be taken to ensure Additional Learning Provision (ALP) will be provided in Welsh, if required.
